Check the planners of students

Sign or initial the planner on behalf of the school.

Where homework was set in the previous week, check that a due date was included. Check that the student, where appropriate, has ticked the completed section and has rated their own work using the traffic light system.

If homework has not been set, 'None Set' with a reason should have been written against the subject.

Students should have monitored their own attendance.

This week is an **even week**. All students should complete the 'expected' subjects for the week in their planner. Tutors should be able to see the subjects written clearly. Please leave a line between each subject.

Tutors will also need to discuss the school council and how they can elect the representatives from their forms. **Wednesday (KS4) and Friday(KS3) Tutorials:**

During these sessions, form groups must decide on the names of students who will represent their respective forms on the school council. Names should be passed to CDA by the end of the week.
