- 1. A huge thank you and congratulations to all involved in the production of this year's production 'The Toad of Toad Halll'. The show was again to a high standard and reflected the hard work and dedication of all involved. Special thanks must go to Mrs Turon, the Director, for planning, coordinating and rehearsing students. As usual, this was a community achievement, with helpers from within and outside of Academy. Performances were held on two nights and a matinee for our local primary schools and were well attended and supported.
- 2. Thank you to the students who participated in the Magistrates' Mock Trial Competition last Thursday and to Mrs Owen for preparing them for this and to Mr Stevenson for accompanying them. Their behaviour was exemplary in the waiting room and in the court rooms; and they were all very well presented. They saw a variety of cases including a stabbing, assaulting a Police Officer and possession of Class B drugs. Even though it can be a little tedious when points of law are discussed and there is a wait for probation reports, but the students managed to sit up straight, in silence, to act respectfully and followed all of my instructions without question.
- 3. At the Governing Body meeting of on 10 February, following extensive research and due-diligence process, the Governing Body voted unanimously to dissolve Looe Community Academy Trust in order to form the South East Cornwall Multi Academy Regional Trust (SMART). The DFE has given its approval for Saltash.net, Liskeard School and Community College, Looe Community Academy, Landulph School, Dobwalls School and Trewidland School to form SMART. The date proposed is April 1<sup>st</sup> 2017.
- 4. The Integrated Health Centre which we are have been planning for two years is finally under construction on the Academy Site. Funded by the NHS, this facility will enable students to have

- support from health care professionals e.g. the school nurse, counsellors etc on the doorstep in purpose built facilities. A well-being day is being planned for students to support its development.
- 5. Reminder to students to observe the signs around the main hall, as there are mock examinations again in progress.
- 6. IRIS technology will be in Science this week which continues teachers' self-evaluation and reflection of lessons.
- 7. Staff are reminded that if for any reason a class is relocated, a notice should be put on the classroom door to say which room you have moved to.
