1. Thank you to Mr George for arranging the Royal Navy & Royal Marines presentation for Year 9 last Wednesday.

3. Feedback on work experience and activity week will take place on Monday 25 July, during Sports Day Heats. Please check the timetable very carefully as there have been changes to the original plan. Any problems please see Mr Keveth.
4. Dress code. I would like to remind you of Safeguarding guidance about professional dress in the workplace. All staff received a copy of this during their Child Protection training. For your convenience I have extracted the appropriate paragraph (below). I would like to remind you that professional dress is expected and as per my bulletin of 24 May, short attire and strappy tops are unacceptable. Whilst we are raising standards and those of children's dress in particular, we must maintain the confidence of parents in the way we dress ourselves.

Paragraph 8 of the Guidance for Safe Working Practice for the Protection of Children and Staff in Education Settings January 2005 – DES states:

8. Dress and Appearance

A person's dress and appearance are matters of personal choice and self-expression.

However staff should consider the manner of dress and appearance appropriate to their professional role which may be different to that adopted in their personal life. Staff should ensure they are dressed decently, safely and appropriately for the tasks they undertake.

Those who dress or appear in a manner which could be considered as inappropriate could render themselves vulnerable to criticism or allegation.

This means that adults should wear clothing which:

- *promotes a positive and professional image*
- *is appropriate to their role*
- *is not likely to be viewed as offensive, revealing, or sexually provocative*
- *does not distract, cause embarrassment or give rise to misunderstanding*

- *is absent of any political or otherwise contentious slogans*
 - *is not considered to be discriminatory.*
