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<p><b>Health and Safety Message</b></p> <p><b>The safe use of electrical extension leads</b></p> <p>It is always preferable to plug all devices in to the mains sockets that are provided throughout the Academy. Where this cannot be achieved, the first consideration should be whether the space can be rearranged to access existing sockets, or whether additional mains sockets can be installed.</p> <p>Where this is not practical, or where there is a temporary need, it may be necessary to use an extension lead. Only leads purchased by the Academy bearing an in-date PAT test sticker can be used.</p> <p>The leads are generally rated to 13 amps, but please establish the fuse rating on the plug and ensure it is suitable for the intended task. The total load of the all appliances that are plugged in to that extension lead should not exceed the extension lead rating.</p> <p>Staff are therefore requested to check any extension leads that they use to ensure that they are in-date and suitable for the equipment they are powering.</p> <p>Please discuss any issues or new requirements with Mr Minnette (or Mrs O'Connell for PAT testing). The online Helpdesk can be used to request support, report defects or request PAT testing.</p>
