Year 11 Prom – Friday 24 June

The Prom will take place on Friday 24 June at the Hannafore Point Hotel, 7pm for 7.15pm when we coordinate the balcony photograph, although many students begin to arrive from 6.30pm due to the long procession of vehicles. There will be marshals assisting with arrivals and with traffic and we respectfully ask onlookers and drivers to be mindful of safety and when students are having their arrival photograph taken. Students are reminded that we, and the hotel, have a strict no smoking and no alcohol policy. Any student who does not comply with these requests will be asked to leave the hotel premises by staff on duty. Once students have arrived in the hotel they are to remain in the ballroom area booked by the Academy and they must be aware at all times that the Hannafore Point Hotel will be operating as normal with customers present, as well as staff and students from the Academy. Please arrange for safe transport home.

The charge will be £25, which will cover the three course meal, hire of the ballroom and the disco/DJ.

A professional photographer will attend to take photos. These images will be then made available on the photographer's website for download to a device for £8 and this can be paid for on ParentPay. The fee will give access to a personalised code to enable the download. Images will also be available to purchase as a printed copy for an additional cost directly from their website. By students having their photograph taken, they are giving their consent for their image to be shared and used in this way.
