Dear Parent/Carer



We are very pleased to be continuing the Duke of Edinburgh's (DofE) Award at our school this year. The Award is a fantastic opportunity for our students to gain new skills, give back to our community, challenge themselves, enrich their learning and enjoy themselves. The DofE Award is a significant qualification, recognised by employers and universities throughout the UK and overseas. You probably know a bit about it already, but further information can be found at <https://www.dofe.org/do/sections/>

We are offering the first stage Bronze Award to Year 10 pupils. In order to complete the Bronze Award, participants will need to complete each of the four sections:

- Physical\*
- Skills\*
- Volunteering\*
- Expedition

(\* One of these must be participated in regularly over six months; the other two must be completed over 3 months).

Students who enrol will be trained and supported to complete the expedition section, with several training activities and assessments being run over the academic year. There are extra curricula activities and opportunities already provided within our school that would enable all students to complete the other sections of the Award. However, your child may already be involved in outer-school clubs and activities that would also fulfil the requirements.

We have been generously supported by the Duke of Edinburgh's Award office to help us establish the programme, and we have purchased a large amount of group equipment (including tents and stoves) to enable us to run the expedition and your child's registration fee will be covered. However, there will be a £160 fee to support the delivery of the expedition events for those students who qualify for the expedition by completing two of the three other sections.

Payment must be made online through ParentPay, and no student will be registered until the form has been returned. For students entitled to Pupil Premium, the academy can assist with some of the cost of the expedition; please call the school or email [finance@looeaca.net](mailto:finance@looeaca.net) to arrange this.
