GCSE Drama Trip - The Hall for Cornwall, Truro - Hamlet performed by The Royal Shakespeare Company

We are delighted to offer your child the opportunity of seeing a live performance of Hamlet performed by The Royal Shakespeare Company at The Hall for Cornwall, Truro on **Thursday 26 February 2026**.

We will travel to the venue by coach, departing from Looe Community Academy at 11am and returning at approximately 7pm, so arrangements will need to be made for your child to be collected from school at this time. Please note that students will not be allowed to leave on foot and must be met by a responsible adult unless express permission is provided prior to departure.

Students may wear their own clothes and must bring a packed lunch and bottle of water. If your child is entitled to free school meals, then a packed lunch will be provided for them. Students will not be allowed to leave the venue at any time.

Due to negotiating a school booking, we were able to secure tickets at a reduced price. The cost of the trip is £16 per student which includes ticket and coach travel. Places are limited and are on a first come, first served basis, once all the tickets are sold there will be no option to purchase more.
