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Dear Parent/Carer

At Looe Community Academy, we are extremely pleased to be able to offer students in Years 7, 8 and 9 the opportunity to take part in Challenge Week 2023.

As with every year, this week promises to be an action packed 5 days that celebrates our students' achievements and allows them to develop their personal learning and thinking skills. For 2023 we have provided the opportunity for students to experience a range of activities that may not be readily available to them during their usual timetabled lessons.

Students can choose one of the fantastic residential experiences on offer or alternatively, they can enjoy the 'home programme' where they can opt for one of our 'challenge packages' that caters for a wide range of interests and budgets.

As your son or daughter will be selecting one package for the duration of Challenge Week, they should carefully consider the activities on offer and liaise with friends before signing up and paying a deposit.

For non-residential activities, in accordance with current regulations, participation in those Challenge Week options that carry an additional cost is by voluntary contribution. For residential activities, in accordance with current regulations, the full cost of board and lodgings will need to be paid. For students whose parents or carers are in receipt of certain benefits, board and lodgings may be remitted on production of suitable evidence. Other costs for residential visits will be by voluntary contribution. Full details can be found in our Charging and Remissions Policy, which is available on our website, but clearly if insufficient funds are raised through voluntary contribution, activities will not be able to take place.

Deposits and top-up payments can be paid via Parent Pay. Details about Parent Pay have been sent previously to you and, if required, login details can be resent for those parents that have not yet activated their account.

Parent Pay will open for deposits on **28**th **February at 8am.** Deposits should be paid by **17**th **March** with top up payments made by the dates set out on Parent Pay. Activities will be available on a first serve basis.

Tuesday: Take to the waves on Cornwall's only surf simulator! Where experienced instructors will have you standing up and surfing in style in no time. Slip, slide and splash around on the inflatable Aqua Park, where there's steps, trampolines and more to jump and bounce your way around the course! And learn how to master the waves whilst stood up on the SUP's. Life couldn't be wetter!









Wednesday: Today's day requires a little less movement. Firstly, a couple of games of ten pin bowling, followed by some time in the arcade, then off next door to the Vue Cinema plymouth to sit back, relax and fill your face with popcorn and sweets whilst kicking back in the leather recliner seats to watch the latest blockbuster movie.



Thursday: It's onto Splashdown Quaywest, the UK's BIGGEST outdoor waterpark, with 8 adrenalin-pumping flume rides. Take on the sheer speed of 'The Screamer' with it's 60 degree steep arc, ride the 'Wild Kamikaze' and accelerate through 60 metres of slide and descend through 3 steep drops! Face the 'Devil's Drop'? The highest, fastest flume in the UK! a 65ft near vertical drop and into a black hole. Ride together with friends down the 'Raging Rapids', Tumble on tyres and whizz through 130m twists and turns in the 'Surf Lagoon' before weaving your way through 112m of open and closed tubes on the 'Sidewinder'. Finish with 98m of 360-degree turns on the 'Corkscrew' & 100 metres of twists and turns on 'Wet & Wild', then do it

all again.....







Friday: The end of the week sees us get the 'most of the coast' at one of Cornwall's finest surf beaches, Fistral. Learn how to surf With expert instruction from the surf team then have some lunch before traverseing the stunning coastline around the headland Coasteering. Jump, climb, swim, let the sea pick you up and take you for a ride...coasteering is an instant rush and you don't need any experience, just a thirst for adventure.

Midlands Safari Park, where students will be able to interact with and witness some of


nature's greatest animals and creatures. The students will then head to our overnight stay


Wetsuits and buoyancy aids or life jackets will be provided but students will need wetsuit boots or training shoes that can get soaking wet.

Wednesday 20 July - Friday 22 July - MountBatten Watersports & Activities Centre

Explore Plymouth Sound by kayak taking in the stunning views of the City's historical and picturesque waterfront from a new perspective. Get Stand Up Paddleboarding in no time at all in the sheltered water directly outside the Centre! We can guarantee you will get wet and have a SUP-er time! Try out your skills on the Centre's Boathouse Climbing Wall and maybe a day sail with a picnic to Drake's Island. Will you learn your port from starboard? Or you bow from your stern? And how about another opportunity, trying Windsurfing in the sheltered waters of Plymouth Sound!







Monday 17th July – Camel Trail <u>This is open to competent cyclists only</u> following the disused railway line, students will cycle approximately 6 miles along the **Camel Estuary from Wadebridge to Padstow.** Once in Padstow, students will have an hour to explore the town before cycling back to Wadebridge. Bikes and helmets will be provided. Please wear suitable clothing and shoes; bring sunscreen, a water bottle and either a packed lunch or money to buy lunch in Padstow.

Tuesday 18th July - Wargame Company, Tavistock, Outdoor Laser Combat

This is a fun way of 'playing soldiers' in team games in the woods without being hit by a projectile. Equipment required will be: shorts and t-shirts with sturdy shoes (overall and hat will be provided), sunscreen, water bottles, snacks, packed lunches and money to buy snacks from the snack machine.

Wednesday 19th July - Coasteering

Coasteering involves scrambling, sea swimming, climbing and cliff jumping your way around a section of the North Cornwall coastline. Students must be fairly competent and confident swimmers. All equipment is provided, students will need swimwear, towel, sunscreen, water bottles and a packed lunch.

Thursday 20th July - Tree Surfing Challenge


Challenge yourself to a treetop adventure that will test your limits, stretch your mind, and give you a natural high! Students will take on the Tree Surfing Challenge combined with a nature walk in the beautiful Tamar Valley. Please wear suitable clothing and footwear; bring sunscreen, a water bottle and a packed lunch for today.

Friday 21st July - Skiing

The final day will be a Ski Experience at Plymouth Snow Sports Centre! Learn the basics of skiing or show off your already developed skills on the ski slope. Students will have qualified instructors to ensure quality tuition for all levels of skier. In addition, enjoy some snow tubing and tobogganing. Students must wear log sleeved tops, trousers and gloves. Please bring a water bottle, packed lunch, sunscreen and money should you wish to purchase food or beverages from the café.







This will be an exciting and challenging opportunity where students can take part in a **residential camping adventure** on the Isles of Scilly. Students travel to **the Isles of Scilly** on the **Scillonian ferry**, camp on the **Cornwall Outdoors** dedicated schools' camp site at **Pelistry Farm** on St Mary's and take part in a range of **exciting and challenging activities**:

- **Coasteering** on St Mary's with Kernow Coasteering (Life on the Edge)
- Swimming with seals from St Martin's with Scilly Seal Snorkelling
- Fast rib ride- from Tresco with Island Sea Safaris
- Bear Grylls adventure on Samson
- **Swimming** on idyllic deserted beaches St Mary's and Samson

The cost of the adventure is £400, which includes all activities, accommodation, food and transport. The adventure will begin with the coach leaving the Academy early on the morning of Saturday 15th July and finish with the coach returning to the Academy late in the evening on Friday 21st July.
