ParentPay will open for deposits on Monday 15 April at 12pm. Deposits should be paid by Monday 29 April with top up payments made by the dates set out on ParentPay. 

all again.....









<u>Sunday 14th July:</u> We will begin our journey by setting off from the Academy on our 'executive coach' to West Midlands Safari Park, where students will be able to interact with and witness some of nature's greatest animals and creatures. The students will then head to Hinkley for an overnight stay at the Premier Inn Hotel, where they will feast on a restaurant evening meal, before getting a well-earned night's sleep.



Monday 15th July On awakening, a choice of breakfast will be provided before travelling the short journey to Alton Towers Theme Park for a choice of an actionpacked day on the rides for the thrill seekers, or a more leisurely approach to the wide range of 'calmer' activities for others. The day will finish by travelling direct to London for a good night's sleep, gearing up for 3 full days of adventures in our nation's capital.

Tuesday 16th July: After breakfast, we will head out for a city stroll, taking in some of the main tourist areas such as Buckingham Palace, Big Ben, Houses of Parliament, Trafalgar Square, Downing Street, Horse Guards Parade and a brief stop off at the beautiful area of Hyde Park. The Banksey Art Tunnel is always a spectacle, before heading to **St Pauls's Cathedral** and all its wonders on show. Once fed and fuelled from our restaurant evening meal, the **Apollo Victoria Theatre** awaits, where we will be heading to witness the West End Show Wicked - The Musical!! Wednesday 17th July: We arise for another filling breakfast before heading to Madame Tussauds! *PLEASE NOTE – Students wishing to participate in this package will be required to share a hotel 'twin room' with another student. It is also strongly advised that in order to maximise their day, students wishing to ride the main rollercoasters at Thorpe Park/Alton Towers pre-purchase their own 'Ride Fastrack Pass' before the trip as only the park admission ticket is included in the cost of this package. There will also be separate, extra costs throughout the week, such as; Tube fairs, lunches and at least one additional evening meal.



The World's most popular diver training course provides you with all the skills required to dive safely and competently worldwide. The course is taught in a fun and friendly manner by professional and internationally recognised PADI instructors and uses the most up to date training techniques.

The PADI Open Water Diver Course includes all course materials, 2 days of dry learning and pool sessions, and 3 days of sea diving – completing at least 4 dives over the 3 days.

At the end of the course, once they've completed all of their training, students will receive their PADI Open Water Diver Certification which means they can dive anywhere in the world with a buddy to 18m max (students under 15yo will have shallower depth restrictions until they turn 15yo).













Monday 15th July - Wargame Company, Tavistock, Outdoor Laser Combat

Equipment required will be: shorts and t-shirts with sturdy shoes (overall and hat will be provided), sunscreen, water bottles, snacks, packed lunches and money to buy snacks from the snack machine.

Tuesday 16th July – Cornish Adventure, Cornish Kayaking.

Get ready for an unforgettable Cornish Kayaking Adventure, where you will learn all the comings and going of Cornwall's local community as well as the local wildlife in the Camel Estuary. All whilst being challenged with games to help improve your paddling skills. Learn the essential kayak skills under the watchful eyes of experienced guides and enjoy the adventure and fun on the sea.

Wednesday 17th July - Coasteering

Coasteering involves scrambling, sea swimming, climbing and cliff jumping your way around a section of the North Cornwall coastline. Students must be fairly competent and confident swimmers. All equipment is provided, students will need swimwear, towel, sunscreen, water bottles and a packed lunch.

Thursday 18th July - Tree Surfing Challenge

Challenge yourself to a treetop adventure that will test your limits, stretch your mind, and give you a natural high! Students will take on the Tree Surfing Challenge combined with a nature walk in the beautiful Tamar Valley. Please wear suitable clothing and footwear; bring sunscreen, a water bottle and a packed lunch for today.

Friday 19th July - Plymouth Karting & Laser Tag


The final day is spent at Devon & Cornwall's ONLY Indoor Karting & Laser Tag centre, home to the fastest indoor karts in the South West! Take on the Challenging indoor racing circuit designed to maximise overtaking opportunities. When not driving enter the Multi level laser tag arena, with different game modes and live scoring for an intense experience. Full safety equipment and briefings from friendly, trained staff & a raised spectator area giving spectacular views of all the action.











This will be an exciting and challenging opportunity where students can take part in a **residential camping adventure** on the Isles of Scilly. Students travel to **the Isles of Scilly** on the **Scillonian ferry**, camp on the **Cornwall Outdoors** dedicated schools' camp site at **Pelistry Farm** on St Mary's and take part in a range of **exciting and challenging activities**:

- Coasteering on St Mary's with Kernow Coasteering (Life on the Edge)
- **Swimming with seals** from St Martin's with Scilly Seal Snorkelling
- Fast rib ride- from Tresco with Island Sea Safaris
- Bear Grylls adventure on Samson
- **Swimming** on idyllic deserted beaches St Mary's and Samson

The cost of the adventure is £450, which **includes all activities, accommodation, food and transport**. The adventure will begin with the coach leaving the Academy early on the morning of **Saturday 13th July** and finish with the coach returning to the Academy **late in the evening on Friday 19th July**.
